N-Pact changes the way growers plan their fertility program

Better uptake of nitrogen that won't burn leaves

October 21, 2008 – Winnipeg, Manitoba – At a time when growers are thinking about the nitrogen levels in their soil as focus turns from harvest to the 2009 growing season, they can now take advantage of new technology to better manage their nitrogen fertility. N-Pact marketed by UAP is a patented Triazone slow release nitrogen fertilizer that allows growers to plan around a more targeted foliar application later in the season.

“What we’re saying is apply less nitrogen to the soil now and then do a tissue sample to measure need for nitrogen later,” said Brodie Blair, Product Manager for UAP Canada Inc., based in Winnipeg. “That’s the advantage of N-Pact’s 26-0-0 foliar formulation. You can apply additional nutrients later as required for filling and protein. It’s easier and more efficient.”

“N-Pact is different than other fertilizers because of the Triazone formulation which allows better foliar uptake without the leaf burning often associated with other nitrogen fertility programs,” said Blair. He cited studies conducted by UAP that show N-pact is 31% more efficient in foliar uptake than other sources of nitrogen, such as urea, nitrate or ammonia.

“Nitrogen is essential for successful production of most crops and nitrogen just got better with N-Pact,” said Blair.

Adding to its convenience, N-Pact can easily be tank-mixed with most other herbicides, insecticides or fungicides and can also be used in irrigation.
