



## **DON'T FORGET THE 2,4-D**

### **GLYPHOSATE IS OFTEN REACHED FOR TO CONTROL ANNUAL AND PERENNIAL WEEDS IN THE FALL. ADD THE 2,4-D FOR BETTER RESULTS**

- For improved control of weeds in minimum tillage systems, summer fallow or fall stubble the addition of 2,4-D is recommended
- Glyphosate labels recommend either 2,4-D Ester or 2,4-D Amine, depending on the situation
- Annual weeds like flixweed and stinkweed in the rosette stage, and others like wild mustard, pigweed, kochia and lady's thumb as well as green foxtail, volunteer canola and volunteer cereals
- Perennial weeds like volunteer alfalfa are controlled more effectively with the addition of 2,4-D in the tank
- For roadside use a tankmix of Glyphosate + 2,4-D Amine + Dicamba is a recommended treatment
