Broad window of application and controls Canada thistle up to 20 cm (8 inches) in height.

Crops: labelled for 31 crops

Field peas: Soon after 3 pairs of leaves form

Soybeans: Unifoliolate to two expanded trifoliolate leaf stage, usually 18 to 20 days after planting

Lima, dry, snap beans (including white, kidney, black, pinto): 1 to 3 trifoliolate leaves

Faba beans: Soon after 3-leaf stage

The recommended rates for Benta Super are 0.7 L/acre to 0.9 L/acre

Water Volume

Ground: Apply with a minimum of 40 L/ac of water.

Air: Apply with a minimum of 20 L/ac of water.

Packaging: 2 x 9 L case

Performance

There are no re-cropping restrictions because there is no carryover.

A contact herbicide with only localized translocation to exposed parts of the plants (i.e. leaves and their cells), therefore thorough coverage is critical.

Rainfall within 6 to 8 hours of application may reduce effectiveness
