APPLICATION PROCEDURES

CROP

Spring wheat (including Durum)

ACTIVE INGREDIENT

Tribenuron-methyl

MODE OF ACTION

ALS-inhibitor (Group 2)

TIMING

Only weeds emerged at the time of application will be controlled. Fields treated with INFERNO WDG Herbicide can be seeded to spring wheat (including Durum) or barley at minimum of 24 hours after application.

RATE

10 g/ha or 4 g/A

PACKAGING

320 g bottle treats 80 acres

WATER VOLUME

55 - 110 L/ha (5 - 10 gal/A) for ground application

GLYPHOSATE TANK-MIXTURE

INFERNO herbicide may be tank-mixed with glyphosate when applied pre-plant or post-plant pre-emergence. Refer to the appropriate product label for use directions.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Add ⅓ of the necessary volume of water to the spray tank.
2. With the agitator running, add the required amount of INFERNO herbicide.
3. Add the glyphosate herbicide.
4. Add the rest of the water. If an antifoam agent is required, add this last.
5. Use a minimum spray volume of 55 - 110 L/ha.
6. For repeat tank loads, reduce the material remaining in the tank to 10% of the original volume or less before proceeding with step 1. If this is not possible, pre-slurry INFERNO herbicide in a small amount (5 - 10 L) of water before adding to the tank.

Continuous agitation is required to keep INFERNO herbicide in suspension. If the spray preparation is left standing without agitation, thoroughly agitate to re-suspend the mixture before spraying. Use spray preparation within 24 hours or product degradation may occur.

CONDITIONS

Apply to young, emerged, actively growing weeds that are less than 10 cm tall or across.

For best results apply to weeds that are actively growing in the stages listed. Wheat exposed to water-logged or saturated soils, temperature extremes such as hot or cold, drought, low fertility, or plant disease immediately prior to or after application could result in unacceptable injury symptoms. Weed control may also be reduced by these same conditions, or if heavy weed infestations exist, or when applications are made outside the application recommendations.

RAINFASTNESS

1 hour

SPRAYER CLEANUP

1. Empty the tank and drain the sump completely. Remove any contamination on the outside of the spraying equipment by washing with clean water.
2. Spray the interior tank walls (including the lid) with clean water using a minimum volume of 10% of the tank volume. Add household ammonia (containing a minimum 3% ammonia) at a solution rate of 1 L/100 L water or ALLCLEAN Cleaner (or other similarly approved cleaner) to the tank. Circulate the water through the lines, including all by-pass lines, for at least two minutes. Flush the boom well and empty the sprayer. Completely drain the sump.
3. Repeat step 2. For this rinse, the addition of household ammonia or other cleaner is not required.
4. Remove the strainers, nozzles, tips and screens and clean separately in a bucket containing water and ammonia solution.

If only ammonia is used as a cleaner, the rinsate solution may be applied to the crop(s) listed on this label. Do not exceed the maximum-labeled use rate. If other cleaners are used consult the cleaner label for rinsate disposal instructions. If no instructions are given, dispose of the rinsate on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
