Thank-you for submitting to us the formula for your agricultural input named "Microthiol Disperss". Ecocert Canada has reviewed the declared formula for Microthiol Disperss against the National Standard of Canada on Organic Production Systems and Permitted Substances List (CAN/CGSB 32.310-2006 and CAN/CGSB 32.311-2006) and the Quebec Organic Reference Standards and Quebec Permitted Substances List for Organic Production Methods.


We have verified that all the declared ingredients appear on the PSL Canada, section 4.3 (see attached ingredient verification table) and PSL Québec, section A 1.1 (see attached ingredient verification table).

We have also verified that the declared processes used in the manufacture of Microthiol Disperss (and its ingredients) are compliant with section 1.4.1. of CAN/CGSB-32.310-2006 and Appendix A of the Quebec Organic Reference Standards.

The Canadian Standard notes the following restrictions regarding use of such a product as a disease control product in organic production: to be used only when cultural crop management practises are unable to prevent disease, and the use of the substance must be documented in the producer's organic plan and activity records, and the equipment used to apply the substance must not present a contamination risk.

We have received a signed contract from your company, "United Phosphorus Inc.", in which you declare that all products marketed as "Microthiol Disperss" are made according to the formula referred to above.
