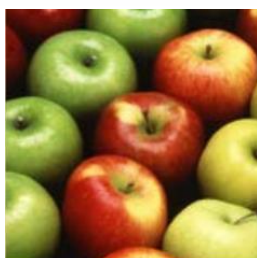

Halosulfuron

Mode of Action

Group 2 – Sulfonylurea – absorbed by roots and foliage

Formulation & Packaging

72.6% Wettable Dry Granular, 24 x 284 g bottles per case

Application Parameters

Post Emergent

Apply when nutsedge has reached 3 - 5 leaf stage*
For broadleaf weeds, apply when small and actively growing
For larger weeds and to broaden control tank-mix with a non-selective, contact herbicide
Use of a non-ionic surfactant recommended

*can control up to 12" or 8-leaf nutsedge

Pre Emergent

Apply before excessive weed growth prevents contact of spray to soil



Application Information

Clean out tank thoroughly before moving to sensitive crops
Apply uniformly with ground equipment in 140 - 190 L water/hectare
If weeds present at application,

Mix Instructions

Water (1/2 tank) - while agitating add:
1. 35 – 145 g Sandea per hectare
2. Remaining water to capacity = 15 gallons/acre or volume for adequate coverage
3. If weeds are emerged include a non-ionic surfactant (NIS)

Restrictions

Avoid spray or drift contact with tree foliage and fruit
Do not apply to trees established less than one year
Do not apply more than 145 g of Sandea per hectare per 12-month period
Pre Harvest Interval (PHI): 14 days
Do not apply to nursery stock
