DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- 1) DO NOT mix SensiCoat directly with chemical concentrates
- 2) Test for compatibility with all components prior to full scale treatment
- 3) Mix or agitate SensiCoat prior to use
- 4) Add SensiCoat to water or to diluted chemicals with constant agitation
- 5) Mix for at least 10 minutes to ensure a homogeneous mixture

SensiCoat should not be applied to products after harvest.

Alfalfa	4 - 8 oz.
Canola	8 - 11 oz.
Corn	0.25 - 0.75 oz.
Delinted Cotton	1 - 3 oz.
Sorghum	0.25 - 0.75 oz.
Soybean	0.20 - 0.75 oz.
Sunflower	2 - 4 oz.
Vegetable	contact manufacturer
Wheat/Rice	0.20 - 1.20 oz.

*The above usage chart is for recommended application rates, some variation in final appearance may occur. Dark seeds or glossy seeds may require higher usage rates. Coating equipment, desired appearance, type of seed, and actives or inert ingredients used may effect usage rates. Adjust rates as needed to achieve desired appearance.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL:

Dispose of contents/container in accordance with all applicable regulations. Protect from freezing and keep away from excessive heat. Store between 35°F - 75°F (2°C - 25°C). Can be stored for up to 12 months in unopened, sealed containers. Refer to Safety Datasheet (SDS) for product hazards, first aid, fire-fighting, accidental release, handling and storage, exposure controls/personal protection, toxicological/ecological information, and disposal considerations. Waste must be disposed of in compliance with local, national and EPA regulations by a licensed waste processing service.
