

Application Guidelines

Registered Plants: Shelterbelt, nurseries and woody ornamental applications:

- Arborvitae
- Ash
- Barberry
- Birch (cut leaf weeping)
- Boxwood
- Caragana
- Cedar (Eastern red)
- Cedar (White)
- Crabapple
- Elm
- Euonymous
- Forsythia sp.
- Heather
- Holly (Ilex spp.)**
- Honeysuckle
- Juniper
- Lilac
- Linden
- Locust
- Maple
- Mock Orange
- Poplars
- Rhododendron
- Rose
- Spirea
- Willow
- Yew (Taxus)

Only trees listed above should be present when Casoron G4 is used in shelter belts, hedgegroves and wind breaks.

** Do not use on the following holly species (Ilex spp.) I. crenata; I. rotunda; I. vomitoria



Do not use on:

- Abies concolour
- Ajuga
- Firs (Abies species such as Balsam Fir)
- Gladiolus
- Hemlock
- Herbaceous perennials
- Holly species (Ilex crenata, Ilex rotunda, Ilex vomitoria)
- Mugho Pine
- Spruce

For annual weed control with repeat applications each year, apply 110 kg/ha for maintenance weed control. Use 175 kg/ha to control grasses and tough perennial weeds every other year.



Fruit Tree and Small Fruit Applications:

Casoron G4 can be used on the following fruit crops.

- Apple
- Cherry
- Cranberries
- Established Saskatoons
- Grapes
- Highbush Blueberries
- Peach
- Pear
- Plum
- Raspberries

Consult label for specific application timing, rates and weeds controlled for each crop.

Activity:

- Casoron G4 is a soil-active herbicide that controls broadleaf and grassy weeds at weed germination and weed growth initiation.
- Water is necessary to move Casoron G4 into the soil. Casoron G4 will stay in the upper 10 cm of soil and will not harm established plants with a well developed root system below this herbicide barrier.

Cautions:

Apply when the daily high temperature is less than 15°C. Higher temperatures that may occur prior to the herbicide washing into the soil may result in gassing off of the herbicide, resulting in reduced control.

Easy to use

Casoron G4 is easily applied to the soil surface with granular application equipment. Apply it with a small hand-held or backpack spreader, or with a tractor mounted or pull-type granular spreader.

Apply Casoron G4 in the autumn before freeze up or in the spring before weeds germinate. If Casoron G4 is applied in warm weather (above 15°C) or on dry soil it should be watered in but not the point of flooding.
