

## Registered crops

Echo is registered for use on the following crops:

**Potatoes** – Late blight (*Phytophthora infestans*), Early blight (*Alternaria*), Botrytis vine rot

**Chickpeas** – Ascochyta blight

**Lentils** – Ascochyta blight, Anthracnose

**Tomatoes** – Early blight, Late blight, Septoria leaf spot, Anthracnose, Botrytis gray mold

**Carrots** – Early blight (*Cercospora*), Late blight (*Alternaria*)

**Blueberries** – Anthracnose fruit rot, *Alternaria* fruit rot, Phomopsis canker

**Cranberries** – Fruit rots, Twigleaf blight, Upright dieback

**Ginseng** – Leaf spot, Gray mold

**Broccoli, Brussel Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower** – *Alternaria* leaf spot, Downy mildew

**Peas (dry)** – Ascochyta blight (*Mycosphaella pinodes*)

**Wheat** – Septoria leaf spot, Septoria glume blotch, Tan spot, Fusarium head blight (scab) suppression
