**Pack Size – 2 x 9 L case**

#### **BENEFITS:**

- Provides tough broadleaf weed control in a variety of broadleaf crops without residual re-cropping concerns.
- Value priced.
- Valuable tool to help you manage herbicide resistance and herbicide resistant weeds.
- Surfactant load can be tailored to your application conditions.

**Rate –** A case treats 25 to 20 acres (0.71 to 0.91 L / acre).

**Water Volume –** 10 - 43 Gal / acre, contact herbicide, good spray coverage is critical in achieving good weed control results, for optimal results use a minimum of 20 gallons of water. Use of Assist® Oil Concentrate or XA™ Concentrate surfactants recommended for improved control of broadleaf weeds, rates depend on crop and weather conditions present.

#### **Application Timing –**

Application timing should be determined by the stage of your primary target weed along with the crop staging.

Soybeans soon after 3 pairs of leaves form.

Lima beans and dry common beans  
1 to 3 trifoliolate leaves.

Peas soon after 3 pair of leaves form.

Flax 2 inches or taller.

#### **Pre Harvest Interval –**

varies based on crop and tankmix partner used, refer to tankmix partner and Broadloom labels for details.

**Rainfast –** 6 - 8 hours.

#### **Post Application Notes –**

There are no re-cropping restrictions as there is no carryover / residual. Use under some environmental conditions may result in temporary crop response. This effect is temporary and the crop out grows it.
