Resistance Management

Hurricane offers two herbicide modes of action (Group 6 Bentazon and Group 14 Acifluorfen). Using multiple modes of action is recommended for weed resistance management. Hurricane offers a broad-spectrum of activity and can be easily tank mixed with many other herbicide products.

Application of Hurricane

The application rate of Hurricane is 1.755 litres per Ha (0.71 litres per acre). The most effective control will result from making post-emergent applications of Hurricane early, when weeds are small - as directed by the label instructions.

- Early application to weeds results in improved weed control.
- Thorough spray coverage of weeds is a must.
- Refer to label for recommended water volume, spray pressure and application equipment.
